the developing and printing yourself. "In the first case the fun is short and sharp, and repeated at intervals. That is, you get the thrill first when you see your pictures at the Dealer's Shop, and then each time you show them to your friends.

"In the second case, you get a long drawn out 'suspensy' kind of thrill, because when you develop the films yourself, you can watch the pictures forming, and it's really terribly exciting.

"To begin with, however, I think I would recommend the first sort of thrill, because the excitement of the second

might be too great for you.

"Of course, when the hobby really gets its hold, the fun gradually increases. Suppose you get a better camera, like the All-Distance Ensign, or the Ensign-Carbine described on other pages, you'll

get better results, and may take up enlarging. If you do, you must be careful, because lots of domestic strife is caused by people staying up all night with their enlargers, producing the most beautiful pictures imaginable. But make a point of sharing the fun with your friends.

"That, sir, in a few words, is where the fun of photography lies. It's real fun, and it's good fun, because it's creative fun, and it's Ensign Film and Ensign Cameras which can give it you best.
